


What Goes Where for Apartments and Condos



Separation of recycling and waste materials is mandatory for all residential and commercial properties. (By-law 32-95)

Organics

Use any bag to collect your organics.
Note: If an organics program does not exist in your building, put these items in the garbage.



All food scraps



Meat/fish bones, shellfish

Coffee grounds, filters, tea bags



Paper towels, tissues, muffin liners, paper plates, pizza boxes



Diaper/adult briefs, feminine hygiene products



Pet waste, kitty litter, fur, animal bedding



Shredded paper

Fats, Oil & Grease

Protect your pipes!
Never pour fats, oils or grease down the sink, drain or toilet.

Pour or wipe it into your kitchen catcher.



Recycling

Items must be empty and clean.
Do not bag. Place loose items in the collection bin or recycling chute (if applicable).



Plastics



Aluminum cans, tins, foil



Glass jars, bottles



Paper, boxboard, cartons

Cardboard

1. Never place cardboard down a chute.
2. Flatten and bring to your waste room.
3. Contact your Property Manager for further instructions.



Cardboard can also be taken to any Markham Recycling Depot (see reverse).

Clear Bag Garbage

CLEAR BAGS ONLY.
NO dark, white, or blue bags.



Coffee cups, lids




Wooden/bamboo cutlery, stir sticks



Drink pouches, snack wrappers



Broken glass



Disposable wipes, dryer sheets, lint



Toothbrush, toothpaste



Padded mailers, bubble wrap

Contact your Property Manager for proper disposal instructions.




Items in good condition should always be donated to a local charity.




Recycle Right, Recycle More


City of Markham offers residents several convenient options to drop off household items for reuse, recycling and safe disposal.




Recycling Depots




Unionville Depot

Accepted Items

- All blue box recyclables
- Cardboard - Large, flattened 3'x3'
- Ink cartridges
- Plastic bags - empty, clean
- Scrap metal - microwaves, frying pan
- Styrofoam packaging, food trays



Green bins, blue boxes available for purchase.

Textile Recycling

- All clean, unwanted clothing and textiles
- Including stained or damaged items
- 160+ bins are located across the city



Alkaline Batteries Only


- A, AA, AAA, C, D, 9V, button
- Store in a clear, plastic bag
- Keep away from heat

- Cell phone, laptop, button, e-bike, power tools
- Cover terminal ends with tape
- Drop off regularly
