Intention to Designate a Property / Ontario Heritage Act

The Council of the City of Markham intends to designate the following property for reasons of cultural heritage value or interest pursuant to the *Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1990*, Chapter O.18, Part IV:

David and Fannie Moyer House
53 Dickson Hill Road
Markham, ON

The David and Fannie Moyer House has design and physical value as a representative example of a vernacular farmhouse with the form and selected stylistic features of the Italianate style, and is a rare example of nineteenth century poured concrete wall construction in Markham. The David and Fannie Moyer House has historical and associative value as the former home of David and Fannie Moyer and their children representing the religious and cultural mosaic theme of Pennsylvania Germans and Mennonites being attracted to Markham Township. The property also has contextual value as one of several heritage buildings and an historic cemetery that are important in defining, maintaining or supporting the character and extent of the historic hamlet of Dickson Hill.
