<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Watering for the first two years gives the trees the best chance to survive.</li><li>• Read the tag on the 50L green bag for further instructions.</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>✓ Ensure the bag is filled once a week from April to September.</li><li>✓ Fill the bag twice a week when there is no rain or hot temperatures for several days.</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>✗ Don't remove the watering bag.</li><li>✗ Don't water the tree too much when there has been a lot of rain, contractors have filled the bag and the mulch around the base of the tree is already very wet.</li></ul>
